Class Entry Fees:	\$5.00 per class OR \$35.00 Ride All Day (rail classes) (does NOT include Sweepstakes) Registration available Friday night during Speed classes
Sweepstakes Fees:	\$5.00 per class OR \$25.00 Ride All Day (speed classes) (does NOT include Sweepstakes) \$10.00 per class – 70% payback to 4 places – no ribbons (40/30/20/10) If 10 or more entries, \$50 added
High Point Nomination:	\$5.00 per division – May only enter one rail and one speed division (points start when fee is paid) NEW: Free High Point Nomination with pre-entry submitted by May 9, 2009 (speed OR rail) Go to www.kricketts.com/Equestrian.htm for pre-entry form There is NO OBLIGATION to show if you pre-enter and are unable to attend.
High Point Divisions:	RAIL: Adult; Age Groups 17-19, 15-16, 13-14, 9-12; Pony 9-19; Novice 9-19; Walk-Trot 9-12, 13-19 SPEED: Age Groups 17-19, 15-16, 13-14, 9-12 (Adult riders may compete in Sweepstakes) * classes do NOT count toward High Point in Rail or Speed divisions
Stall Fee:	\$20.00 – refundable upon inspection only (if staying for Jr. Meet, please note on entry form)
Camping:	\$15.00 per night (whether hooked to electric or not – get camping pass at booth)

Stalls and camping for the Middle School Equestrian Team Meet must be paid separately on Sunday.

All fees charged are a donation to Lenawee Co. Horse and Pony Board and the Tecumseh Equestrian Teams
Cups or ribbons given to Youth and Adults 1st – 6th place
Food Wagon on grounds
All dogs **MUST** be on leashes.

Current Michigan 4-H rules apply

Entries close when preceding class enters ring.

All tack changes must be requested two classes prior. Once the gate closes, no one will be allowed to enter the ring.
Exhibitor age as of 1/1/09

Adult: 19 and over, or 2008 or earlier graduate

Novice – 1st and 2nd year showing only (Walk-Trot does not count as a showing year).

Novice riders may only show in Novice classes unless Novice class is not offered.

Riders cannot show in Age Group AND Novice. If you have shown in Age Groups in Lenawee County, you may no longer show in Novice.

Walk-Trot can only show in Walk-Trot classes unless no Walk-Trot class is offered.

Walk-Trot classes include horses and ponies and are broken into two age divisions: 9-12 and 13-19.

Children under the age of nine (9) as of 1/1/09 can only show in Lead-Line – must have boots and SEI helmet.

Adult or senior youth are required to lead any Lead-Line participants.

All riding classes over 20 will be split and have a prelim and final.

All Novice Classes and Walk-Trot Classes over 15 will be split and have a prelim and final.

Show Committee and Judges reserve the right to split, combine, or cancel classes.

A “Junior Horse” is any horse age 5 and under

Pony Class limited to exhibitors aged 9-19.

Pony Height not to exceed 56” and requires valid pony measurement card upon registration.

Must have proof of 2009 negative Coggins at registration.

Approved snaffle bit required for dressage.

Riders may compete in a maximum of two dressage tests.

Riders are responsible for cleaning up after their horses on grounds and in stalls.

Judges’ and Show Committee’s decisions are final.
